Sunday, January 7th Blackstone River Greenway, 2:00-4:00 p.m. Blackstone River and Canal Heritage State Park Meet at the Adams Street parking area in Uxbridge

~4 miles round trip over easy terrain, paved surface.

Sunday, January 14th Mammoth Rock Trail, 2:00-4:00 p.m.

Upton State Forest

Meet at the CCC Camp parking area (42.209180, -71.608770). ~2 miles over moderate terrain, mild elevation, rugged forest trail

Sunday, January 21st Wallis Pond Loop, 2:00-4:00 p.m.

Douglas State Forest

Meet at the Route 16 parking area (42.055991, -71.786420). ~3 miles over moderate terrain, mild elevation, loose graveled surface.

Sunday, January 28th SNETT, 2:00-4:00 p.m.

Blackstone River and Canal Heritage State Park

Meet at the Franklin Trailhead at 234 Grove Street, Franklin. ~4 miles round trip over easy terrain, paved surface.

Sunday, February 4th Hike To Goat Hill Lock, 2:00-4:00 p.m. Blackstone River and Canal Heritage State Park Meet at the Visitor Center at River Bend Farm.

~2 miles round trip over moderate terrain, rugged forest trail.

Sunday, February 11th Sparrow and Grouse Trail Hike, 2:00-4:00 p.m. Upton State Forest

Meet at the CCC Camp parking area (42.209180, -71.608770). ~3.5 miles over moderate terrain, steep incline, rugged forest trail.

Sunday, February 18th Tri-State Marker Loop, 1:00-4:00 p.m.

Douglas State Forest

Meet at the parking area by the Wallum Lake Boat Launch

(42.021936, -71.767987).

~5 miles round trip over moderate terrain, mild elevation, loose graveled surface.

Sunday, February 25th Blackstone River Greenway (WVC), 2:00-4:00 p.m.

Blackstone Heritage Corridor Visitor Center

Meet at the Millbury Street parking area in Worcester

~2.75 miles round trip over easy terrain, paved surface.
